Amendment to the Compliance Notification Enforcement Extension Position Statement

For organisations qualifying for Phase 3 the deadline for submitting a compliance notification is the 5 June 2024. The Environment Agency advised we will not take enforcement action against you if completed your notification by the 6 August so long as you registered by the 5 June.

We are aware that some organisations have been unable to complete their registrations and may not meet the deadline of 5 June.

Organisations must continue to register as soon as possible but the Environment Agency will not take enforcement action if you submit your notification of compliance by the 6 August 2024.

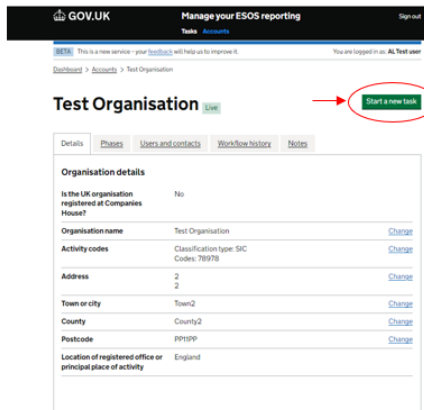
This regulatory enforcement extension period will cease after the 6 August 2024.

MESOS Reporting System Update

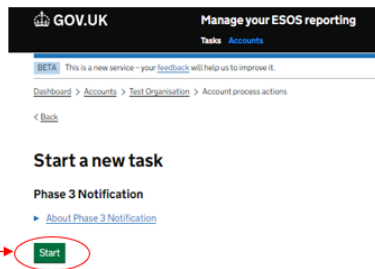
The Manage your Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme [reporting system](#) (MESOS) has now seen around 7,000 accounts successfully created to date.

As reported in our last newsletter the notification of compliance functionality is now enabled. In order to carry out this action you must have registered an organisation account within the MESOS system.

In order to complete your notification of compliance please follow the steps below:

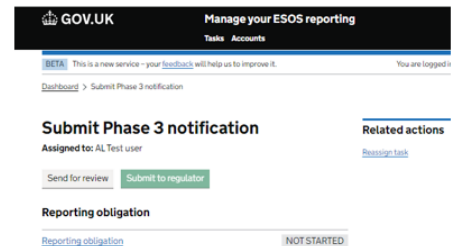

- Login at <https://manage-energy-saving-opportunities-reporting.service.gov.uk/>
 - Select "Accounts" section.
 - Select your organisation account.
1. Click the Green button which says, "Start a new task".
 2. Then, on the next page, click "Start" button.
 3. This starts the notification workflow.
- Once the NOC is started, you can access it as a Task in the Dashboard.

MESOS Guidance

Guidance on how to compile and complete the notification of compliance can be found in the attached **MESOS data requirements template**. This template is provided as a tool which lead assessors / responsible undertakings may wish to use to help them collect the information needed to notify compliance with the Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS). Notifications must be submitted via the online system, MESOS, in order to be compliant.

Also attached is an updated version of the **Appendix B: Information to provide through the ESOS notification system document**, which sets out the information that will need to be notified to comply with the Phase 3 requirements.
