# Compliance Notification Enforcement Extension Position Statement

For organisations qualifying for Phase 3 the deadline for submitting a compliance notification is the 5 June 2024.

Organisations must continue to register as soon as possible but the Environment Agency will not take enforcement action if you submit your notification of compliance by the 6 August 2024.


This regulatory enforcement extension period will cease after the 6 August 2024.

## **MESOS Reporting System Update**

The Manage your Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme <u>reporting system</u> (MESOS) has now seen around 7,500 accounts successfully created to date, and around 4,000 notifications of compliance either completed or underway.

As a reminder, in order to submit your notification of compliance you must have registered an organisation account within the MESOS system.

In order to complete your notification of compliance please follow the steps below:



### Notification of compliance guidance

Guidance on how to determine energy consumption by organisational purpose can be found in the attached **Guidance on Organisational Purpose** document.

This document is provided as a guide which lead assessors / responsible undertakings may wish to use to help when determining how to calculate the information needed within the 'Energy Consumption' section of the notification of compliance.

#### **MESOS User management**

Once a new user has been added to an existing organisation account on MESOS, their user account must be activated by an existing Advanced User for that organisation account for them to gain full access to the service.

The existing Advanced User must log in to MESOS, select 'Accounts' at the top of the screen, and then select the relevant organisation account. They can then select the Users and Contacts tab where they will see all the users on that account. They must then change the Account status of the relevant user from Accepted to Active, and click Save.









## **MESOS Task management**

Tasks can only be 'reassigned' to Advanced Users, and not to Restricted Users. Tasks can only be 'sent for review' to Restricted Users, and not to Advanced Users.

To reassign a task, users must go to the Dashboard and select the task. They must then click 'reassign task' on the right hand side of the screen, and select the user from the drop down menu, and click Confirm and complete. This will then transfer ownership of the task to another Advanced User. You should note that if there are no other Advanced Users on the account then no names will appear in the drop-down menu.

To send a task to a Restricted User for review, users must go to the Dashboard and select the task. They must then click 'Send for review' and select the user from the drop-down menu, read the information, and click Confirm and send. The Restricted User will then be able to amend and review the task before sending it back to the Advancer User. You should note that if there are no Restricted Users on the account then no names will appear in the drop-down menu.
